



Welby's PTA-sponsored program where students become familiar with master artists and learn art techniques modeled after those master artists.

Getting Ready to Present

(2-3 days before)

1. Look at Artist Schedule to find out which master artist is assigned that month.
2. Review Artist File--Online http://schools.jordandistrict.org/welby/Welby/ART_smart.html or check folder out from art supply closet. Sign-out folder and return file as soon as you are done.
Each Artist File contains:
 - PowerPoint CD (pictures of artist and artwork)
 - printed copy of slides
 - volunteer notes, lesson plan and sample project.
3. Feel free to improvise and/or simplify the project. Practice project, if needed.
4. Contact teacher to remind them:
 - the day and time you are coming
 - to help you set up the iPad/computer and projector.

Day of Presenting

1. Arrive 15-30 minutes before scheduled time, depending on project.
2. Gather supplies from supply closet.
3. Before teacher leaves: ask for help to set up iPad/computer, projector and PowerPoint CD.
4. Set up classroom—set up supplies, paints, etc.
5. Art Lesson & Project.
6. Return Artist Files and supplies to supply closet and put in proper places.

Art Lesson Time-Pacing

Artist Study (PowerPoint) - 10 minutes

*-Focus on well-known facts
-Ask what kids notice (colors, lines, abstract, etc. See "Walk Through the Painting")*

Art Project - 30-40 minutes

-Each piece should be labeled on back with child's name and name of artist

Clean Up - 10 minutes

-Students help
